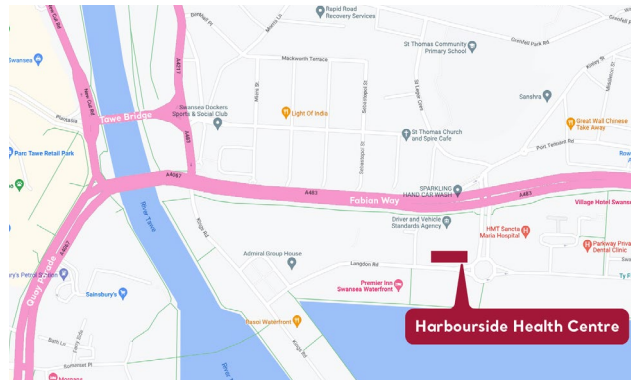

Harbourside Health Centre is in the new SA1 Development by the Waterfront & Docklands area.

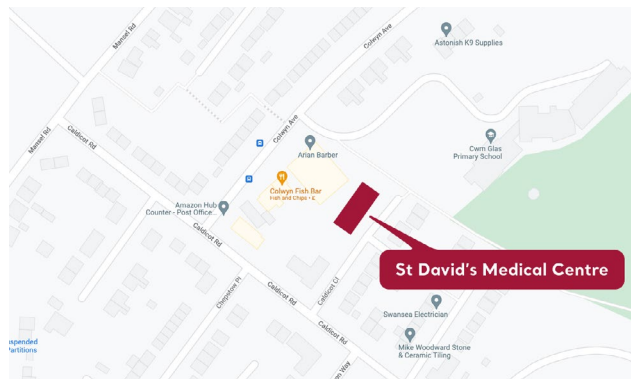

For easy and fast way to seek advice or appointment, please submit your request via Ask My GP by visiting our website and clicking on Ask My GP logo.

You can use a smartphone/computer with internet access. Enter your details, problem and submit the request. You can also seek help by Ask My GP, on behalf of someone you care for, as long as the patient is registered with the practice. If you do not have access to internet, please phone the surgery to be added to the triage list.

Our phones are answered between 8am to 6:30pm.

For repeat prescription requests, you can make online requests through My Health on-line, a 24/7 service, enabling you to request repeats at a time that suits you. To register for this service submit your request by emailing:

My Health on-line is only for repeat medication, please use Ask My GP to request for any other medication related query.

Please note the date of review of your medication, indicated on the bottom right hand part of your prescription. Please make an appointment for review with appropriate professional at least 2 weeks prior to review date.
