Public Health Wales is running a 'Beat Winter Viruses' campaign, which encourages people in Wales to take simple actions to prevent the spread of common illnesses this winter.

The campaign is particularly focused on encouraging people to wash their hands for at least 30 seconds at key moments throughout the day.
